<ul> <li>The foam-style earplug isn't adequate protection against the noise from the jackhammer.</li> <li>The worker is wearing a ball cap under his hard hat, which could impact the fit.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>The worker has an unsafe and wide stance with his back foot on top of a hose and his left foot on the wall.</li> <li>The worker isn't using his equipment correctly. His foot is too close to the jackhammer.</li> <li>The hoses are a tripping hazard.</li> </ul>
Various lumber is laying around the worksite instead of being stored in one place. This is a tripping hazard
The worker should not be trying to listen to his cell phone. Not only is the distraction a hazard, but he's removed his hearing protection to listen which can result in hearing loss.
<ul> <li>There's some unidentified bags in the background which may contain food. Food doesn't belong next to a bucket of chemicals.</li> <li>The saw horse is unstable and is missing a leg.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Foam-style earplugs aren't adequate protection against the noise from the jackhammer and other work site noise.</li> <li>The worker isn't wearing safety goggles.</li> <li>His safety vest is open and tangled enough that the reflectors are difficult to see.</li> <li>The worker is wearing a ball cap under his hard hat, which could impact the fit.</li> <li>He is distracted by the other worker with the cell phone while using a buzz saw</li> </ul>
The worker has poorly tied shoes
The scaffolding leaning in the background isn't secured.
